

Q. What about on-site registration?

A. On-site registration will be set up at the COBO Center dure, please contact the international Convention coordiand will open on Wednesday morning, July 1, 2020.

Q. Must everyone register? I thought I didn't have to pay to go to an A.A. event.

A. Yes. Everyone must register. Attendance at this special celebration is voluntary, and, as responsible A.A. members, "we pay our own way." The International Convention is paid for by those A.A.s who participate in

#### How much will registration cost?
