Dear A.A. Family,

IT IS INTERGROUP BOARD ELECTION TIME!!

Positions on the Board of Officers shall be elected at the regular November Intergroup meeting (Monday, November 8th, 2021) and installed at the January meeting (Monday, January 10th, 2022). Officers hold office for a period of two (2) years. The **Secretary** and **Treasurer** positions are to be voted upon this year. At the October Intergroup meeting (Monday, October 11th, 2021), any member of AA may stand for one but not both positions up for election. They can do this by being present at the October Intergroup meeting and announcing their intention to run. Candidates must have at least two (2) years of continuous sobriety when placed in nomination. The Duties of each position are as follows:

SECRETARY

The duties and service obligations of the Secretary include:

- A. Record minutes of Intergroup meeting.
- B. Attend all Intergroup-sponsored functions.
- C. Make certain that all necessary materials are made available at Intergroup meetings, such as sign-in sheets, etc.
- D. Perform other duties that the Chairperson may request.
- E. Must be familiar with the By-Laws and 36 principles.

TREASURER

The duties and service obligations of the Treasurer include:

- A. Require skills of current bookkeeping system.
- B. Prepare a monthly financial statement and present this report at Representatives meetings.
- C. Attend all Intergroup-sponsored functions.

- D. Perform any other duties the Chairperson may request.
- E. Must be familiar with the By-Laws and 36 principles.

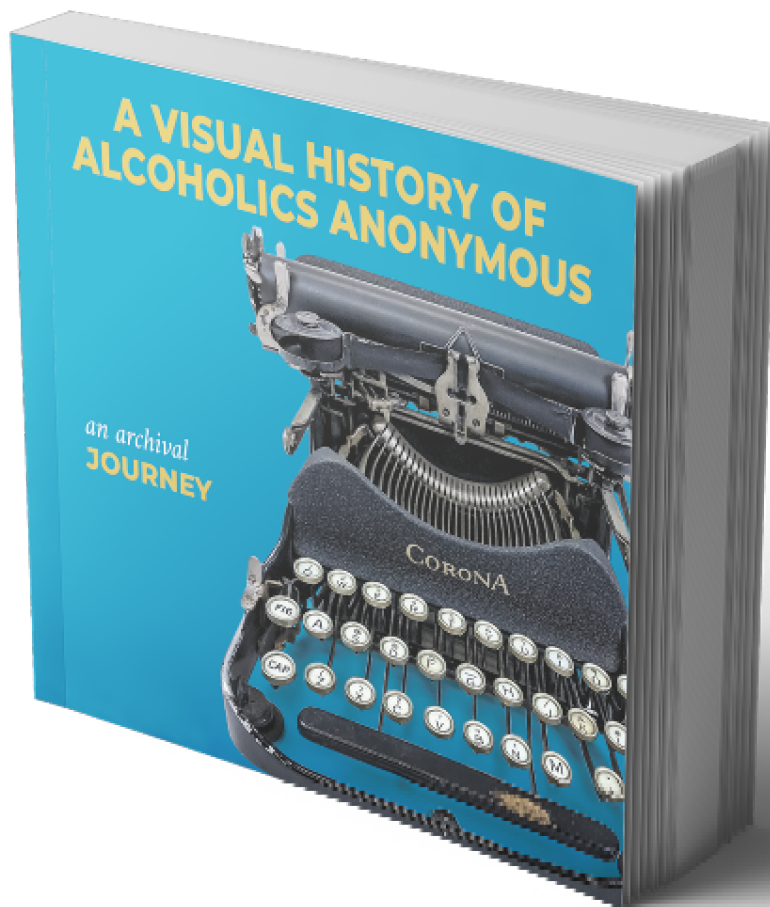

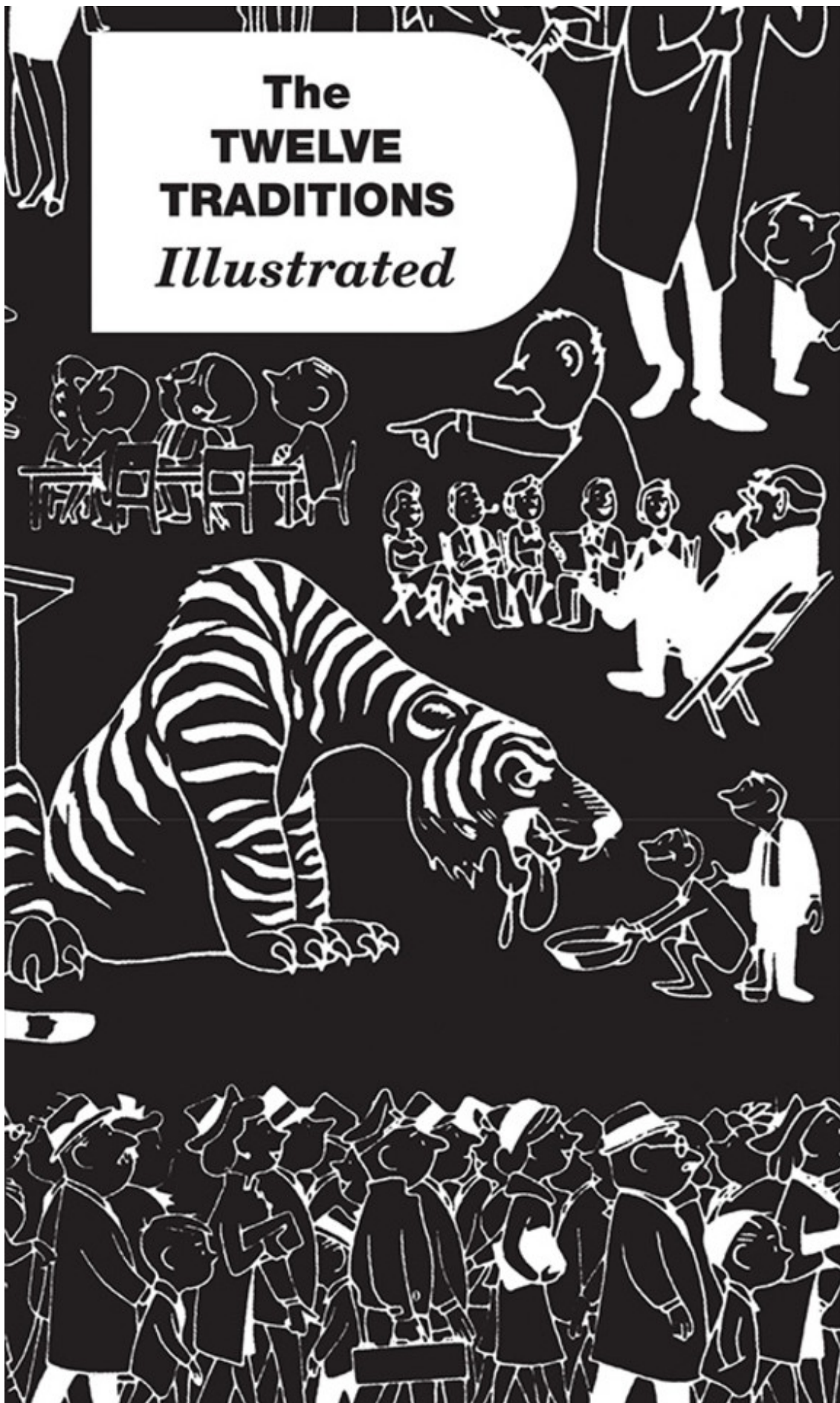


September Grapevine Book of the Month: Our Twelve Traditions

Questions of finance, public relations, donations, and purpose are addressed in the Traditions. They were originally written by Bill Wilson after the founding of the first twelve-step group, Alcoholics Anonymous.

The Mary Lyons Detox Center has no groups signed up to bring experience, strength, and hope to their facility from now until January 2022. This is usually done by a bid process once a year at the District 3 Meeting. In keeping with our 5th Tradition which states, "Each group has but one primary purpose- to carry its message to the alcoholic who still suffers." We are reaching out to you! Meetings are Wednesdays at 8:00 PM and Sundays at 2:00 PM. If any groups or AA members are willing to go to the detox center and carry the message please reach out to the Heartland Intergroup office manager at officemanager@heartlandintergroup.org. In these trying times detox has a few new rules:

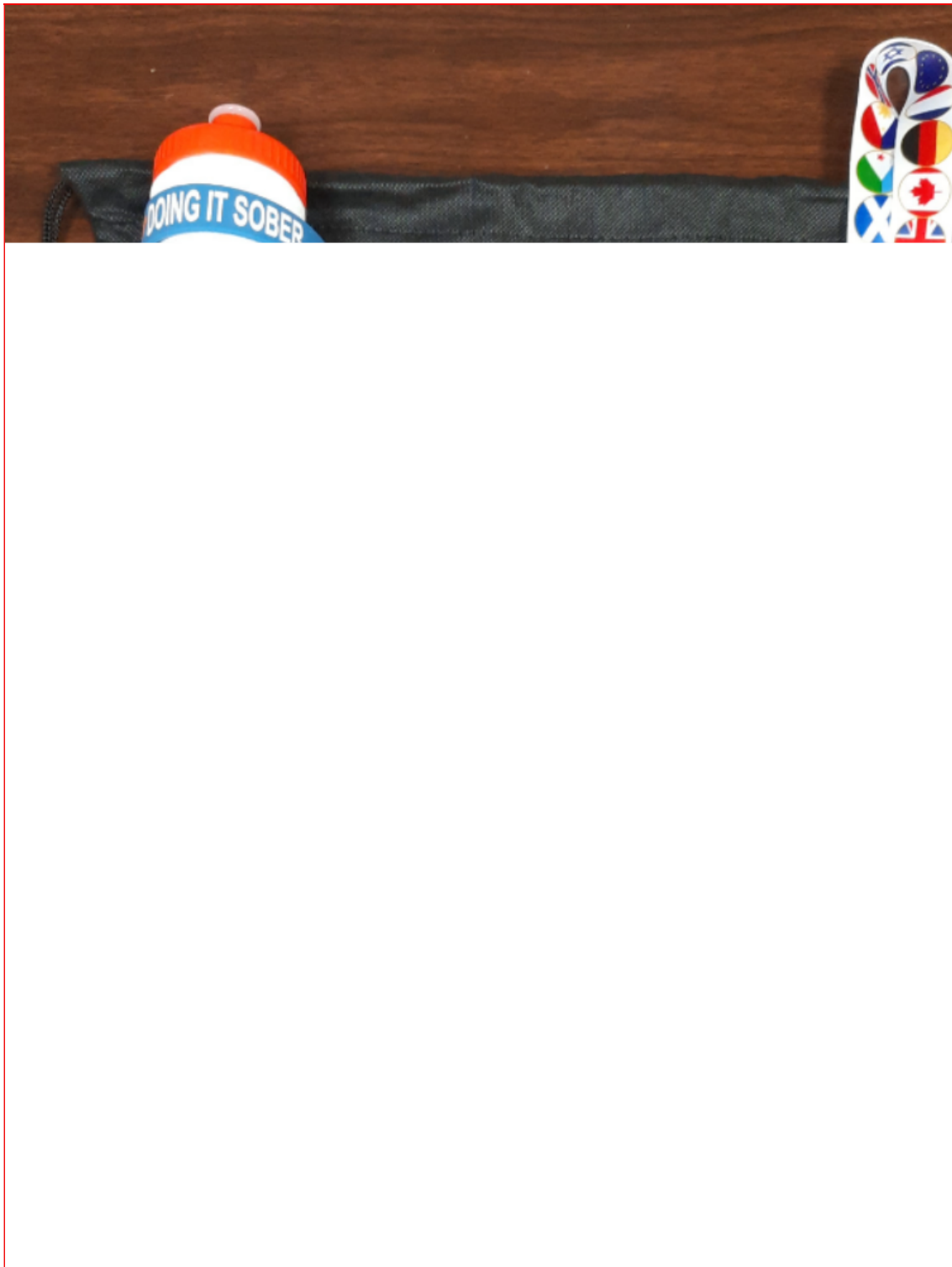
1. Must wear a mask at all times
